We use the article "a" if the noun it describes begins with a **vowel sound** (not just a vowel). We use the article "a" if the noun it describes begins with a **consonant sound** (not just a consonant).

Example: **a** dog (consonant /d/ sound); **a** helicopter (consonant /h/ sound)
